## Conexus' Plexus Vision Solution Selected for Medical and IT Equipment Asset Tracking

*Salt Lake City, UT, April 10, 2018:* Conexus, Inc. today announced it was awarded a contract by Nellis Air Force Base 99<sup>th</sup> Medical Group for the installation of the Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) based Plexus Vision Asset Tracking Solution at the Mike O'Callaghan Military Medical Center. The system will be used to enhance the visibility of medical equipment and IT assets throughout the hospital and nearby clinics.

"Implementing RFID at the Nellis AFB hospital is a significant opportunity for realizing cost savings and enhancing safety while improving overall service and care for military service personnel and their families," said Conexus' Chief Executive Officer and founder, Mr. Laker Dunford.
